GIZ proposed through its 'Support to Local Government Processes' (SULGO) program to support ALAT's efforts to carry out a membership survey. The primary objective of this survey was to gain insights to enhance ALAT's institutional capacity to perform more efficiently as a member-based organization.

The data collected and evaluated was also intended to be used as a database which informs policy and provides guidelines on ways for ALAT to move forward.

ALAT had initially designed the survey questionnaires and started data collection. SULGO commissioned DPC to evaluate and improve the survey instruments, coordinate the data capture and cleaning, and do the data analysis and reporting.
