The Association of Local Authorities of Tanzania (ALAT) exists to support and strengthen the development of Local Government Authorities (LGA's) throughout the country. It works to maintain and promote the interests, rights and values of local authorities and represent their views at the national & international level.

DPC was contracted to analyze the data collected from 44 Local Government Authorities in regard to CBNRM in their districts. Based on the results, we compiled an internal report for use by ALAT officials for strategic planning purposes. An external report was also created for wider distribution to funders, partners and government officials.

The purpose of the survey was to get a picture of past, current and potential CBNRM in the different LGAs. It was also to determine the kind of information about CBNRM that was needed and how LGAs wanted to receive it.

For this DPC compiled the data in a format allowing data analysis. In this process, the data was cleaned and open-ended questions were coded. DPC then did quantitative analysis and presented the results.
