The overall objective of the GIZ assisted program 'Support to Local Governance Processes (SULGO)' is: "Citizens use demand-oriented and decentralized services and benefit tangibly from their participation in local governance processes, which are increasingly embedded in a legally protected framework."

The purpose of the assignment was to support the SULGO management in carrying out a survey on the achievement of program objective indicators. The survey fieldwork was carried out in SULGO partner Local Government Authorities (LGAs) in Tanga and Mtwara Region and the corresponding Lower Local Government Authorities (LLGAs).

For this assignment DPC conducted fieldwork through semi-structured interviews with LLGA officials and citizens, and triangulated the quantitative findings with the qualitative data collected by Focus Group Discussions (FGDs). DPC analyzed the data and constructed an index to measure each indicator by a unique value. DPC then wrote the report presenting the findings. Electronic data capture methods were used throughout the data collection process.
