The objective of the assignment was to geographically map the Embassy portfolio, identify opportunities, and provide recommendations that will enhance synergies and maximize the impact of interventions.

All results areas in the *Results strategy for Sweden's international development cooperation in Tanzania 2013-2019* were mapped. The results strategy has three main components:

- 1) More jobs and developed energy and agricultural markets
- 2) Improved education and increased entrepreneurship
- 3) Strengthened democratic accountability and transparency, and increased awareness of human rights.

The Research portfolio of the Embassy was also mapped, i.e. the support to research and innovation system through the development of research capacity, and through strengthening the linkages between academia, public, and private sectors.

Particular emphasis of the synergy strengthening exploration was on jobs, energy, agricultural markets, private sector development, entrepreneurship, and research.

Among the recommendations were to: 1) Link the supported programmes aiming to promote women, trade, and agriculture; 2) Explore further linkages where there is a geographic concentration; 3) Use the Multi-Dimensional Poverty Index and the Tanzania Human Development Index which have been developed for Tanzania; 4) Integrate the youth dimension (including female youth) into interventions in order to reap the fruits of a young productive population, and 5) Establish a forum for the supported partners for networking and collaboration.
